<u>HB1155</u>	Bentley	CONCERNING THE COMPLIANCE OF CHILDCARE FACILITIES WITH LOCAL REGULATIONS WHEN SEEKING LICENSURE UNDER THE CHILDCARE FACILITY LICENSING ACT.
<u>HB1171</u>	Haak	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR RELIGIOUS DENOMINATIONS TO QUALIFY AS SELF-INSURERS.
<u>HB1321</u>	Holcomb	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING TRUCK PLATOONING SYSTEMS.

HB1324	Vaught	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING VEHICLE HEADLAMP REQUIREMENTS.
HB1224	Bentley	TO ALLOW A REDEMPTION DEED OR SALE DEED TO BE CANCELED AND A PENALTY IMPOSED IF THE PAYMENT INSTRUMENT USED TO REDEEM OR PURCHASE TAX-DELINQUENT PROPERTY FAILS OR IS DISHONORED.
