<u>HB1437</u>	Maddox Boyd	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ON A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY BY AN EMPLOYEE OF A UTILITY, TELECOMMUNICATIONS, OR CABLE COMPANY.
<u>HB1441</u>	Schulz McKee	TO RESTRICT THE USE BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR MEDICAL, EMERGENCY MEDICAL, AND AMBULANCE SERVICES.
<u>HB1455</u>	Gazaway Tucker	TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 17 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING PROFESSIONS, OCCUPATIONS, AND BUSINESSES.
