Legislative Impact Statement

Bill: HB1032 Bill Subtitle: TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE HOMESTEAD PROPERTY TAX CREDIT.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Rep. L. Fite

HB1032 increases the Homestead Property Tax Credit from \$375 to \$425. The Homestead Property Tax Credit reduces the amount of real property taxes due on a property owner's qualified homestead for each assessment year. To claim the credit, a property owner registers with the county assessor and provides proof of eligibility for the credit.

Taxpayer Impact :

A homeowner that receives the Homestead Property Tax Credit will receive a credit of \$425 against their real property tax liability.
