We've reviewed the amendments for both bills and neither change our previous estimates.

The prosthetics bill is basically adding the condition that they be medically necessary.

The PANS amendment slightly loosens some of the restrictions for treatment, but shouldn't be a materially change and I think the BCBS data we based our calcs on was a bit conservative anyway.
