

Arkansas Medicaid Program – Fiscal Impact Estimate for SB 278 March 9, 2023

Bill Subtitle: TO **TERMINATE** ARKANSAS THE HEALTH AND OPPORTUNITY FOR ME PROGRAM; AND TO TRANSFER ALL BENEFICIARIES IN THE ARKANSAS HOME AND OPPORTUNITY FOR ME PROGRAM TO THE TRADITIONAL ARKANSAS MEDICAID PROGRAM.

Annual Estimated Total Spending Reduction: \$867,440,028

Annual Estimated Reduction in State SGR Obligation: \$ 52,415,675

Annual Estimated Reduction in State and Local

General Tax Revenues: \$80,411,691

The fiscal impact in future years after SFY2024 will depend on multiple factors including changes in healthcare inflation, enrollment, and utilization.

DHS estimates there would also be increased operational costs due to higher demands on state employee staffing; contracts; prior authorization (PA) workloads, including pharmacy and treatment; and claims payments to cover increased FFS population.
