SPECIAL LANGUAGE REVISIONS

LANGUAGE TO BE CODIFIED

DISBURSING PROCEDURES – language states that DWS shall file a quarterly report certifying benefit payments made to former state employees by state agencies and once the FRO is satisfied the payments were made accordingly agencies will be reimbursed.

REPORTING – language states that every even-numbered year the CFO shall file a report to ALC summarizing all transferred appropriation and additional positions in relation to unanticipated federal funds.

FUNDING TRANSFER – FIRE AND POLICE PENSION – language states how funds are to be transferred to the Fire and Police Pension Fund.

FUND RESTRICTIONS – FIRE AND POLICE PENSION – language states that funds distributed under the Funding Transfer special language shall not be used to enhance recipient benefits.

WORK FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION – language states how available funds are to be distributed from the Work Force 2000 program, including limits on how much is available to institutes, rules in case there are status changes, and limits on what funds can be used for.

LANGUAGE TO BE DELETED

CREDIT TO THE INDIGENT PATIENTS FUND – language states that revenue derived from 15 extra days of dog-racing is remitted to ASU – Mid-South then deposited as special revenue to credit the Indigent Patients Fund.
