### **ASSUMPTIONS - BASED ON:**

In 2023-2024 school year, 22 districts participated in the cost-sharing paid maternity leave program representing 38,036 students. The state paid 50% of the total cost in the amount of \$136,394.22 or \$3.59 per student. If every district participated (475,207 students) the estimated full cost of the program would be 3,408,112.74.

#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Bill makes foster care placement a qualifying event. This is not accounted for in the fiscal impact.
