

Bill: HB1470 Bill Subtitle: TO REPEAL THE LAW CONCERNING THE REVIEW OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PLANS.

Basic Change:

HB1470 repeals § 19-11-269. Section 19-11-269 requires that the Office of State Procurement ensure that required information is submitted to the Office of Intergovernmental Services within the Department of Finance and Administration (IGS) for review before contracts to procure information technology products or services are executed. This requirement applies to contracts that:

- Procure information technology products or services with a total projected contract amount of at least \$100,000; or
- Purchase information technology products or services under a cooperative purchase agreement.

Under HB1470, these contracts will no longer be forwarded to IGS for review.
