DESE would need to develop a mechanism to audit hours submitted by parents. Currently, schools report through the state reporting system which parents do not have access. DESE would be required to hire personnel to monitor student hours submitted by the parent, legal guardian, or person standing in loco parentis to the student, since this legislation does not

require the parent, legal guardian, or person standing in loco parentis to the student to submit those hours to the school.
