Bill: SB387 Bill Subtitle: TO REPEAL THE LAW REQUIRING OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING ENTITIES TO SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS GRANTED AUTOMATIC OCCUPATIONAL LICENSURE AND EXPEDITED OCCUPATIONAL LICENSURE.

Basic Change:

SB387 repeals the requirement that an agency who issues certain occupational licenses provide an annual report of the number of individuals granted automatic occupational licensure and expedited occupational licensure.

The Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) issues a report annually and provides the report to the House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs. DFA issues a small number of automatic or expedited occupational licenses. One example that would typically be included in the report is a driver's license or commercial driver's license issued to a member of the public by reason of the person's military status.

DFA would continue to be able to provide the information included in the report upon request by the General Assembly. Employees typically tasked with preparing the report would be able to devote the time to other duties.
