

Bill: SB97 Bill Subtitle: TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF ADDITIONAL RETAIL LIQUOR PERMITS TO CERTAIN EXISTING HOLDERS OF RETAIL LIQUOR PERMITS.

Basic Change:

SB97 permits a holder of a retail liquor permit to obtain up to two additional retail liquor permits. Current law prohibits a person, firm, or corporation holding a retail liquor permit from having any interest in another retail liquor permit.

SB97 authorizes the holder of a retail liquor permit to obtain up to two additional retail liquor permits. A permit holder may not hold more than one retail liquor permit in the same county, unless the additional permit is for a county with a population of 200,000 or more.

Fiscal Impact:

Taxpayer Impact:

The holder of a retail liquor permit would be eligible to obtain up to two additional retail liquor permits.

Adequate time is provided for implementation.

Procedural Changes:

Employees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division (ABC) will need to be trained on the change in application procedures. ABC Enforcement agents will need to be trained on this change.
