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3	URGING THE ARKANSAS CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SUPPORT A		
4	REDUCTION OF THE PROPOSED CRITICAL HABITAT DESIGNATIONS FOR THE		
5	RABBITSFOOT MUSSEL AND THE NEOSHO MUCKET AND TO ENCOURAGE THE		
6	UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE TO ADOPT A FINAL RULE		
7	THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ENDANGERED		
8	SPECIES ACT AND THAT IS BASED ON SOUND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCE AND AN		
9	ECONOMIC ASSESSMENT THAT CONSIDERS THE CUMULATIVE ECONOMIC		
10	IMPACTS OF THE DESIGNATION OF CRITICAL HABITAT FOR THE		
11	RABBITSFOOT MUSSEL AND THE NEOSHO MUCKET.		
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13	WHEREAS, on July 12, 2011, after a year-long, nonpublic mediation with		
14	the Center for Biological Diversity, the United States Fish and Wildlife		
15	Service settled a multi-district litigation through a Stipulated Settlement		
16	Agreement pursuant to which the service agreed to seek to list and designate		
17	critical habitats for approximately forty-six (46) species in Arkansas; and		
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19	WHEREAS, the service first considered in Arkansas Neosho muckets and		
20	rabbitsfoot mussels, which the service listed as endangered and threatened,		
21	respectively, by a final rule published September 17, 2013; and		
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23	WHEREAS, the service now proposes to designate as critical habitat for		
24	Neosho muckets and rabbitsfoot mussels approximately seven hundred sixty-nine		
25	(769) river miles throughout Arkansas, the watersheds of which occur in		
26	thirty-one (31) counties covering approximately forty-two percent (42%) of		
27	the geography of Arkansas; and		
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29	WHEREAS, a coalition of associations and public interest groups,		
30	spearheaded by the Association of Arkansas Counties, filed comments to the		
31	proposed critical habitat designation for rabbitsfoot mussels and Neosho		
32	muckets that seek to reduce the critical habitat by approximately thirty-		
33	eight percent (38%) to approximately four hundred seventy-seven (477) river		

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miles; and

1 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Legislative Council recognizes that designating 2 seven hundred sixty-nine (769) river miles with a watershed covering forty-3 two percent (42%) of Arkansas as critical habitat will have a potentially 4 devastating economic impact on private and public land owners throughout 5 Arkansas, including farmers, ranchers, timber producers, oil and gas 6 producers, utility providers, county and municipal governments, school 7 districts, irrigation districts, and countless small businesses, 8 9 NOW THEREFORE, 10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH 11 GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 12 13 THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council joins with the Association of 14 Arkansas Counties and other stakeholders in seeking to reduce the critical 15 habitat designations for the rabbitsfoot mussel and the Neosho mucket. 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas Legislative Council urges the 18 Arkansas Congressional Delegation to support in every possible way the 19 reduction of the proposed critical habitat designations for the rabbitsfoot 20 mussel and the Neosho mucket and to encourage the United States Fish and 21 Wildlife Service to adopt a final rule that is consistent with the 22 requirements of the Endangered Species Act and that is based on sound 23 biological science and an economic assessment that considers the cumulative 24 economic impacts of the designation of critical habitat for the rabbitsfoot 25 mussel and the Neosho mucket. 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, the

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Secretary of the Senate shall mail a copy of this resolution to each member of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation.
