12	WHEREAS, Wendy was born to Judy Kay and William Frank Robert in Conroe,
13	Texas, on August 15, 1970; and

15	WHEREAS, it was at Sam Houston State University that Wendy met and fell
16	in love with her future husband of 27 years, Blake Anderson, and together
17	they traveled from New Mexico to Texas and from Tennessee, Mississippi, and
18	North Carolina before settling in Jonesboro with Blake as head coach of the
19	Arkansas State University Red Wolves football team; and

21	WHEREAS, the people of Jonesboro and the State of Arkansas came to
22	embrace Wendy and her family as she played a behind-the-scenes but powerful
23	role of support and was called "Mama Wendy" by her legions of friends and
24	admirers; and

26	WHEREAS, Wendy, devoted mother of Coleton, Callie, and Cason, was an
27	entrepreneur as well as an advocate for children struggling with dyslexia,
28	and provided learning methods and resources for them as a private tutor; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Wendy was a constant warrior against her disease and a woman
31	of tremendous faith with a deep love of family and friends, and her memory
32	will remain a constant blessing to her husband and children; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, Governor Asa Hutchinson said in a message to Coach Anderson
35	and his family, "The whole state shares your loss",
