34	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-7-610 is amended to read as follows:

36	(a)(1) Any member of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System shall be

- 5 (A) Makes an application to the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas 6 Teacher Retirement System;
- 7 (B) Provides proof satisfactory to the board of that 8 person's service in the Arkansas National Guard <u>or in a reserve component of</u> 9 the armed forces of the United States; and
- 10 (C) Pays to the system for each year of service credit 11 being granted:
- 12 (i) The product of the sum of the employee and
  13 employer contribution rates in effect at the time of purchase multiplied by
  14 the greater of:
- 15 (a) The annual salary received by the member 16 for his or her first full year of credited service that precedes the fiscal 17 year in which the service is purchased; or
- 18 (b) The average of the three (3) highest 19 salaries earned at the time of purchase; plus
  - (ii) Interest from the end of that year of credited service to the date of payment in full.
    - (2) If the payment for service under this section is not made in a single lump-sum payment, interest shall accrue from the date of the initial payment to the date of the payment in full.
    - (3) The payment shall be credited to the member's account in the members' deposit account and shall be in addition to regular member contributions.
    - (b) Members shall receive one (1) year of purchased service credit for each five (5) years of <u>service in the</u> Arkansas National Guard <u>or in a reserve</u> component of the armed forces of the United States <u>service</u>.
    - (c) The Service in the Arkansas National Guard service or in a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States shall not become credited service under this system until:
  - (1) The member payments specified in subdivision (a)(1)(C) of this section have been paid in full; and
  - (2) The member has established five (5) or more years of actual

- (d) If a member ceases to be an active member before the <u>service in</u> the Arkansas National Guard <u>service or in a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States</u> has been established as system-credited service, the member payments contributed as specified in subdivision (a)(1)(C) of this section shall be refundable, together with regular interest.
- (e)(1) This section shall be supplemental to § 24-7-602, and nothing in this section shall be construed to diminish the right of any member of the system to obtain credited service in the system for active duty military service within the limits permitted by § 24-7-602.
- (2) However, no member shall be entitled to or receive in excess of five (5) years of credited service rendered by the member under this section.
- (f) Except for service credit under § 24-7-602(e), service credit in the Arkansas National Guard <u>or in a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States</u> shall not be given if the service is credited under any other retirement plan, including a federal military retirement.

SECTION 2. The purpose of this act is to address disparities in the allowance of purchasing service credit in state retirement systems for members of the Armed Forces Reserves and the Arkansas National Guard.
