AN ACT TO CONTROL THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN
INGREDIENTS UTILIZED TO MANUFACTURE
METHAMPHETAMINE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO CONTROL THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN
INGREDIENTS UTILIZED TO MANUFACTURE
METHAMPHETAMINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-1001 is amended to read as follows:

5-64-1001. Recordkeeping required.

Any manufacturer, wholesaler, retailer, or other person that sells, transfers, or otherwise furnishes any of the following substances to any person in this state shall maintain accurate records of those transactions:

- (1) Phenyl propanol amine;
- (2) Methyl amine;
- (3) Ethyl amine;
- (4) D-lysergic acid;
- (5) Ergotamine tartrate;
- (6) Diethyl malonate;

- 1 (7) Malonic acid;
- 2 (8) Ethyl malonate;
- 3 (9) Barbituric acid;
- 4 (10) Piperidine;
- 5 (11) N-acetyl anthranilic acid;
- 6 (12) Pyrrolidine;
- 7 (13) Anthranilic acid;
- 8 (14) Ephedrine;
- 9 (15) Norpseudoephedrine;
- 10 (16) Phenylacetic acid;
- 11 (17) Morpholine; ~~and~~
- 12 (18) Pseudoephedrine;
- 13 (19) Paint thinner;
- 14 (20) Denatured alcohol;
- 15 (21) Iodine;
- 16 (22) Propane;
- 17 (23) Butane; and
- 18 (24) A product containing lye as a primary ingredient.
