AN ACT TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF NEGLIGENT
DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF NEGLIGENT
DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

5-73-134. Negligent discharge of a firearm.

(a) A person commits negligent discharge of a firearm if he or she negligently discharges a firearm in a manner that creates a substantial risk of physical injury to another person or property damage to a home, residence, or other occupiable structure.

(b) Negligent discharge of a firearm is a Class A misdemeanor.
