34	(a) As used in this section:		
35	(1)(A) "Civilian Student Training Program" or "C-Step	<u>Progra</u>	<u>m"</u>
36	means the diversion program that is administered by the Arkansas Na	ti onal	

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1	Guard for at-risk students who are referred to the program by juvenile court.	
2	(B) "Civilian Student Training Program" or "C-Step	
3	Program" includes a nine-week residence phase and a twelve-month after-care	
4	program.	
5	(C) "Civilian Student Training Program" or "C-Step	
6	Program" uses a structured, discipline-based, military-styled education and	
7	behavioral management model to teach each student participant to improve his
