- (a) The examination of applicants for a license in any of the branches or practices of cosmetology shall include both a practical demonstration and written and oral test and shall embrace the subjects concerning the particular branch or branches, practice, or practices for which a certificate of registration and license is applied.
- (b) The examination shall not be confined to any special system or method.
- (c) The examination shall be consistent in both practical and technical requirements and of sufficient thoroughness to satisfy the State Board of Cosmetology as to the applicant's skill in, and knowledge of the practice of the occupation or occupations for which a license is sought.
- (d) In the conduct of examinations, practical demonstrations shall prevail over written tests. A greater number of credits shall be allowed on practical demonstration than on written tests.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-26-309 is amended to read as follows: 17-26-309. Examination for cosmeticians or cosmetologists <u>and all</u> branches of cosmetology.

Examinations for certificates of registration and license as cosmeticians or cosmetologists and all branches of cosmetology shall include both a written core and law test and a practical test that include embraces all phases of cosmetology as deemed necessary by the State Board of Cosmetology to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-26-315 is amended to read as follows: 17-26-315. Reciprocity.

Upon application to the State Board of Cosmetology in the form provided for the particular class of license applied for, accompanied by the required fee, a person registered or licensed as a cosmetologist, electrologist, manicurist, aesthetician, or instructor under the laws of another state shall be granted a certificate of registration and a license to practice the
