15	school lunch student funding; and if these school districts are not permitted
16	to continue to use these funds for that purpose the school districts will
17	face a serious financial threat. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
18	exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
19	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
20	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
21	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
22	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
23	<u>bill; or</u>
24	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
25	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
