12	WHEREAS, Arkansas has recorded unprecedented growth in population
13	and industry in certain areas of the state that disproportionately
14	burden the existing highway system; and

16	WHEREAS, the majority of Arkansas motorists utilize a minority of
17	Arkansas highway miles; and

19	WHEREAS, the current allocation of the excise tax on motor fuel
20	for the financing of highway projects does not account for traffic
21	flow, traffic count, and highway use,
22	
23	NOW THEREFORE,
24	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE 86TH GENERAL
25	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26	
27	THAT the House and Senate Interim Committees on Revenue and
28	Taxation study Arkansas highway construction and repair costs to
29	determine the disparity, if any, in Arkansas highway construction and
30	repair costs based on the topography, highway use, and traffic count.
31	
32	BE IF FURTHER PROPOSED that the House and Senate Interim
33	Committees on Revenue and Taxation study the equity of the distribution
34	of taxes collected and remitted to the Arkansas State Highway and
35	Transportation Department for Arkansas highway construction and repair;

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the House and Senate Interim Committees on Taxation and Revenue study the feasibility of collecting a sales tax on gasoline and reallocating the tax proportionally according to costs of construction and repair, highway use, and traffic count; and BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the House and Senate Interim Committee on Taxation and Revenue prepare a report detailing the results of the study on or before May 31, 2008.
