AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL PERSONS RECEIVING

ILLEGAL DRUGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to require all persons receiving benefits through the Department of Human Services to undergo random testing for illegal drugs.
