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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-11-129 is amended to read as follows:
22	6-11-129. Data to be accessible on website.
23	(a)(l)(A) Effective September 1, 2014, a school district or public
24	charter school shall maintain a website and post on the website a link to the Department of
25	Education's website with:
26	(i) All information or reports identified in this
27	section; and
28	(ii) Any other information not protected by state or federal law or
29	regulation or report the school district or public charter school is required by
30	law or rule to report, file, submit, or otherwise provide to:
31	(a) The General Assembly;
32	(b) The Department of Education; or
33	(c) The Department of Higher Education.
34	(B) This section does not remove a school district's or
35	public charter school's obligation under law or rule to report, file, submit,
36	or otherwise provide the information.

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1	(2) The State Board of Education shall cite a school district's
2	failure to comply with this section as a violation of the Standards for
3	Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts.
4	(b)(1) Each A school district shall make the following information and
5	data easily identified identifiable on its website or the website of the
6	school district's education service cooperative, if the education service
7	cooperative maintains the school district's website:
8	(A) Current comprehensive financial data reports for <u>the</u>
9	school districts district, including:
10	(i) Local and state revenue sources;
11	(ii) Administrator and teacher salary and benefit
12	expenditure data;
13	(iii) School district balances, including legal
14	balances and building fund balances;
15	(iv) Minutes of regular and special meetings of the
16	school <u>district</u> board of directors;
17	(v) The school district budget for the ensuing year,
18	which shall be posted on the website within thirty (30) days following the
19	date required to be submitted to the Department of Education;
20	(vi) A financial breakdown of monthly expenses of
21	the school district;
22	(vii) Salary schedules for all <u>school district</u>
23	employees, including extended contract and supplementary pay amounts;
24	(viii) Current contract information with all school
25	district employees, except that social security numbers, telephone numbers,
26	personal addresses, or signatures shall not be published;
27	(ix) The annual budget of the school district; and
28	(x) The annual school district statistical report;
29	and
30	(B) Each The school district's personnel policies required
31	under § 6-17-201 et seq.; and
32	(C) Effective September 1, 2014, to the extent not already
33	published on the school district's website under subdivision (a)(l)(A) of this
34	section, the information and all electronic reports a school district is required to provide under the rules of the State
35	Board of Education or by law.
36	(2)(()) Information The information and data required to be made

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1	available and easily accessible on the school district's website under
2	subdivision (b)(l)(A) of this section shall be are the actual data for the
3	two (2) previous school years and the projected budgeted information for the
4	current school year.
5	(2) The information or data identified under subdivisions
6	(b)(l)(B) and (C) and subsection (c) of this section are the most current
7	information or data required to be reported, filed, submitted, or otherwise
8	provided by law or rule.
9	(b)(d) The department shall make the information and data required by
10	this section available and easily accessible on the department's website by
11	including direct links to the websites of all Arkansas school districts <u>and</u>
12	of the education service cooperatives that maintain school district websites.
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14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-1017(c), concerning the programs and
15	services of education service cooperatives, is amended to read as follows:
16	(c) Education <u>An education</u> service cooperatives cooperative may:
17	(1) provide Provide shared educational programs and services
18	such as_needs assessment and school improvement planning, staff development,
19	curriculum development, itinerant teachers, instructional materials, adult
20	and vocational education, programs for gifted and talented, education for
21	children with disabilities, alternative educational programs, secondary area
22	vocational centers, and community-based education programs;
23	(2) Maintain the website of a school district served by the
24	education service cooperative; and
25	(3) Provide other services which the State Board of Education
26	may approve or which school districts may support with local funds.
