24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2202(a)(1), concerning school district
27	budget guidelines is amended to read as follows
28	(a)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ The board of directors of each school district, open-
29	enrollment public charter school, and education service cooperative annually
30	shall prepare a budget of expenditures and receipts that complies with normal
31	budgetary guidelines established by the State Board of Education and which
32	shall be filed with the Department of Education by September 30 of each year
33	under this subchapter.
34	(B) A school district, open-enrollment public charter
35	school, or education service cooperative that wishes to deviate from normal
36	budgetary guidelines may request a waiver from the department.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2207(a)(1), concerning normal budgetary guidelines is amended to read as follows: (a)(1) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules governing a uniform budget and accounting system and normal budgetary guidelines that shall be known as the "Arkansas Educational Financial Accounting and Reporting System". This system shall include a uniform chart of accounts known as the "Arkansas Financial Accounting Handbook" that shall be exempt from the rule-making process pursuant to under the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
