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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:						
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 27 is amended to add an						
24	additional subchapter to read as follows:						
25	20-27-101. Legislative intent.						
26	(a) The General Assembly finds:						
27	(1) Bisphenol-A is a synthetic estrogen used in the production						
28	of some food and drink containers, including baby bottles, and epoxy resins						
29	used to coat food cans and bottle tops;						
30	(2) The majority of bisphenol-A human absorption is by contact						
31	with the mouth and skin;						
32	(3) Infants and children may be exposed to bisphenol-A by their						
33	playthings, food containers, and skin products;						
34	(4) Studies have confirmed that bisphenol-A is harmful to						
35	infants and children; and						
36	(5) This chemical poses a threat to children at critical.						

1	sensitive stages of their development.						
2	(b) The intent of this act is to prohibit in this state the						
3	manufacture, sale, and distribution of children's products containing						
4	bisphenol-A to prevent the harmful effects to infants and children that						
5	studies confirm can result from exposure to those chemicals.

7	20-27-102. Definitions.						
8	As used in this section:						
9	(1) "Baby food" means a prepared solid food consisting of a soft						
10	paste or an easily chewed food that is intended for consumption by children						
11	two (2) years of age or younger and is commercially available;						
12	(2) "Infant formula" means a milk-based or soy-based powder,						
13	concentrated liquid, or ready-to-feed substitute for human breast milk that						
14	is intended for infant consumption and is commercially available; and						
15	(3) "Reusable food or beverage container" means a receptacle for						
16	storing food or beverages, including without limitation a:						
17	(A) Baby bottle;						
18	(B) Baby bottle liner;						
19	(C) Cup;						
20	(D) Cup lid;						
21	<u>(E) Straw;</u>						
22	(F) Sippy cup;						
23	(G) Sports bottle; and						
24	(H) Vacuum bottle.

26	20-27-103. Sale of children's products containing bisphenol-A.						
27	(a) On and after October 1, 2012, no person shall manufacture, sell,						
28	offer for sale, or distribute in this state:						
29	(1) A reusable food or beverage container intended for use by a						
30	child three (3) years of age or younger that contains bisphenol-A;						
31	(2) Any instrument designed to assist a child three (3) years of						
32	age or younger in eating or drinking that contains bisphenol-A, including						
33	without limitation a:						
34	(A) Bottle nipple;						
35	(B) Child's fork;						
36	(C) Child's spoon;						

1	(D) Bib; or						
2	(E) Bottle warmer; and						
3	(3) Pacifiers, teething aids, and crib teething rails that						
4	contain bisphenol-A.						
5	(b) On and after October 1, 2012, the following shall be conspicuously						
6	labeled as not containing bisphenol-A when sold, offered for sale, or						
7	distributed in this state:						
8	(1) A reusable food or beverage container intended for use by a						
9	child three (3) years of age or younger;						
10	(2) Any instrument designed to assist a child three (3) years of						
11	age or younger in eating or drinking, including without limitation a:						
12	(A) Bottle nipple;						
13	(B) Child's fork;						
14	(C) Child's spoon;						
15	(D) Bib; or						
16	(E) Bottle warmer;						
17	(3) Pacifiers;						
18	(4) Teething aids; and						
19	(5) Crib teething rails.						
20	(c) On and after July 1, 2014:						
21	(1) No person shall manufacture, sell, offer for sale, or						
22	distribute in this state infant formula or baby food stored in a container						
23	that contains bisphenol-A; and						
24	(2) Infant formula and baby food shall be conspicuously labeled						
25	as not containing bisphenol-A when sold, offered for sale, or distributed in						
26	this state.						
27	(d)(1) A person violating this section shall be subject to a fine						
28	of not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) nor more than two thousand						
29	five hundred dollars (\$2,500).						
30	(2) Fines shall be assessed by the Department of Health.						
31	(3)(A) Each manufacture or distribution of a product in						
32	violation of this section shall constitute a separate violation.						
33	(B) Each day of selling or offering to sell a product in						
34	violation of this section shall constitute a separate violation.						
35	(e) The department may promulgate rules to implement this section.
