20	TO ALLOW A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO KEEP ANY
21	EXCESS UNIFORM RATE OF TAX COLLECTION
22	REVENUES THAT REMAIN AFTER FULLY FUNDING
23	STUDENT FOUNDATION FUNDING FOR THE SCHOOL
24	DISTRICT FROM THE UNIFORM RATE OF TAX
25	COLLECTION.
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28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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30	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2305(a)(4)(B) and (C), concerning
31	uniform rate of tax revenues, is amended to read as follows:
32	(B) For a school district whose net revenues are more than
33	the sum of ninety-eight percent (98%) of the uniform rate of tax multiplied
34	by the property assessment of the school district and the school district
35	received state foundation funding aid, the Department of Education, under the

1 authority of § 6-20-2306, shall recoup from the school district an amount 2 equal to the difference between: 3 The net revenues of the school district; and 4 The sum of ninety-eight percent (98%) of the 5 uniform rate of tax multiplied by the property assessment of the school 6 district. 7 (C) Beginning with the 2009-2010 school year, a school 8 district whose net revenues from the uniform rate of tax are sufficient to 9 cover foundation funding without state foundation funding aid may retain all uniform-rate-of-tax revenues collected for the benefit of the school 10 11 district. 12 (C)(D)(i) Data to verify the timely receipt of revenues applicable to the required ninety-eight percent (98%) of the uniform rate of 13 14 tax multiplied by the property assessment of the school district shall be 15 collected annually by the Department of Education in cooperation with the 16 Assessment Coordination Department. 17 (ii)(a) Data may be appropriately adjusted by the 18 Department of Education if it is determined that irregular distributions by a 19 county treasurer of excess commissions cause a school district's property tax 20 collection rate from the uniform rate of tax to exceed ninety-eight percent 21 (98%). 22 (b) The Department of Education may adjust the 23 uniform rate of tax from an irregular distribution to an amount not in excess 24 of ninety-eight percent (98%) and apply the excess distribution amount the 25 following school year. 26 (iii) Evidence of irregular distributions shall be 27 in the form required by the Department of Education. 28 29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-5-305(b), concerning the Public School 30 Fund, is amended to read as follows: 31 (b) The Public School Fund shall consist of those moneys as may be 32 provided by: 33 The Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.; (1) 34 Any federal mineral leasing funds, federal forest reserve

funds, federal flood control funds, or any other similar turnback funds in

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1	the State Treasury for which the eligible county or school district cannot be
2	identified;
3	(3) Fines collected pursuant to § 6-21-410 under the Free
4	Textbook Act of 1975, § 6-21-401 et seq.;
5	(4) Funds remitted by county treasurers for those school
6	districts which have local revenue per student in excess of the local base
7	per student, as set out in § 26-80-101(c);
8	(5) Amusement machine revenues up to and including thirty
9	thousand dollars (\$30,000), as set out in § 26-57-407;
10	(6) Additional rental vehicle tax revenues in excess of two
11	million eight hundred $\frac{1}{2}$ fifty thousand dollars (\$2,850,000), $\frac{1}{2}$ as set out in
12	§ 26-63-302, to be used exclusively for teacher salaries; and
13	(7) Such other funds as may be authorized by law.
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15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-80-202(b)(1)(A) and (B), concerning the
16	uniform rate of tax, is amended to read as follows:
17	(b)(1)(A) The uniform rate of tax shall be assessed and collected in
18	the same manner as other school property taxes, but the net revenues from the
19	uniform rate of tax shall be remitted to the Treasurer of State and
20	distributed by the state to the county treasurer of each county for
21	distribution to the school districts in that county as provided by subsection
22	(c) of this section.
23	(B) No portion of the revenues $\underline{Revenues}$ from the uniform
24	rate of tax shall $\underline{\text{not}}$ be retained by the state but shall be distributed back
25	to the school district from which the revenues were received or to other
26	$\frac{\text{school districts pursuant to}}{\text{under}}$ subsection (c) of this section.
