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31	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 6-13-617 is amended to read as follows:

33	(a) Each director e	elected or appointed shall <del>, within ten (10) days</del>
34	after receiving notice of h	ais or her election or appointment, subscribe to
35	the following oath:	

1	"1,, do hereby solemnly swear or		
2	affirm, that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the		
3	Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and that I will not be interested,		
4	directly or indirectly, in any contract made by the district of which I am a		
5	director, except as permitted by state law and that I will faithfully		
6	discharge the duties as school director in

9	County, Arkansas, upon which I am		
10	about to enter."		
11	(b) The person shall take the oath under subsection (a) of this		
12	section:		
13	(1) Within ten (10) days after receiving notice of his or her:		
14	(A) Election in an annual school election held in		
15	September under § 6-14-102(a)(1);		
16	(B) Election in a special election; or		
17	(C) Appointment; or		
18	(2) On or after January 1 but not later than January 10 of the		
19	year following the year in which the person was elected in an annual school		
20	election held in November under § 6-14-102(a)(2).		
21	(b)(c) The county clerk, upon receipt of the oath prescribed for a		
22	director, shall immediately immediately shall commission such persons, and		
23	they the person, and the person shall enter at once upon their his or her		
24	duties as <del>directors</del> <u>a director</u> .		
25	(d) The term of office of a director shall begin on the later of:		
26	(A) January 1 following the director's election in an		
27	annual school election held under § 6-14-102(a)(2); or

32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-618(a), concerning the organizational		
33	meeting of a school district board of directors, is amended to read as		
34	follows:		

1	(a)(1) At the first regular meeting following the annual school		
2	election, the board of directors of each school district shall organize by		
3	electing:		
4	$\frac{(1)}{(A)}$ One (1) of their number president;		
5	$\frac{(2)}{(B)}$ One (1) of their number vice president; and		
6	$\frac{(3)}{(C)}$ A secretary who may be, but need not be, a member		
7	of the board of directors.		
8	(2) If the annual school election is held under § 6-14-		
9	102(a)(2), this subsection applies to the first regular meeting held after		
10	January 1.		
11	(b) The county board of election commissioners may include the annual		
12	school election on a separate ballot if:		
13	(1) The election is held under § 6-14-102(a)(2); and		
14	(2) The board determines that a separate ballot is necessary to		
15	avoid voter confusion.

17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-14-102(a)(1), concerning the annual		
18	school election date, is amended to read as follows:		
19	(a) <del>(1)</del> The <u>board of directors of a school district shall set the date</u>		
20	<u>that the</u> annual school election <del>shall</del> <u>is to</u> be held in <del>each</del> <u>the</u> school		
21	district <del>of the state on</del> <u>as</u> the <u>:</u>		
22	<u>(1)</u> third Tuesday in September; or		
23	(2) Tuesday next after the first Monday in November of each		
24	<u>year</u> .
