REQUESTING THE INTERIM HOUSE COMMITTEE ON INSURANCE AND COMMERCE STUDY THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, FINANCING, AND OTHER OPTIONS aVAILABLE TO NEEDY ARKANSANS FOR THE PAYMENT OF FUNERAL AND BURIAL COSTS.

WHEREAS, funeral and burial costs have increased rapidly during the past decade; and

WHEREAS, the state's neediest citizens are most affected by rising funeral and burial costs; and

WHEREAS, unexpected funeral and burial costs coupled with the inability to pay those costs needlessly exacerbates the trauma of losing a loved one; and

WHEREAS, even citizens with funeral and burial insurance policies often find that the policies have fallen behind the pace of the rising cost of funeral and burial services; and

WHEREAS, states such as Illinois have developed programs to assist their neediest citizens with the costs of funerals; and

WHEREAS, a state-supported funeral and burial benefit fund for the needy should be implemented in Arkansas,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INTERIM HOUSE COMMITTEE ON INSURANCE AND COMMERCE OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Interim House Committee on Insurance and Commerce study the financial assistance and financing options available to Arkansans for the
payment of funeral and burial costs and the establishment of a statesupported benefit fund to help needy Arkansans pay for funeral and burial services.
