

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2011-176

REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REFER TO THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE A STUDY OF THE STANDARDS FOR SUSPENDING, REVOKING, AND DENYING LICENSES TO CHIROPRACTORS.

WHEREAS, chiropractors necessarily work intimately with citizens; and

WHEREAS, licensure discipline of chiropractors falls exclusively within the purview of the Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners; and

WHEREAS, the conduct of chiropractors can have serious health and safety effects,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council of the Eighty-Eighth Arkansas General Assembly refer to the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor a study of the standards for suspending, revoking, and denying licenses to chiropractors.
