7	INCLUDE CERTAIN SPECIAL LANGUAGE IN THE DEPARTMENT'S
8	APPROPRIATION BILL.

10	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE INTERIM HOUSE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND
11	GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
12	ARKANSAS:
13	
14	THAT the Interim House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
15	Affairs study the employee compensation practices and procedures for the
16	Department of Correction, including straight time, overtime, and holiday
17	compensation.
18	
19	BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED THAT the Interim House Committee on State Agencies and
20	Governmental Affairs study whether to include the following special language
21	in the department's appropriation bill:
22	
23	"SECTION [XX]. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
24	ARKANSAS CODE.
25	(a) This section is intended to comply with § 21-5-205(a).
26	(b)(1) At the request of an employee of the Department of Correction,
27	the Director of the Department of Correction or the director's designee may
28	grant compensatory time instead of regular or overtime compensation under the
29	Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, § 21-5-201 et seq.
30	(2) If a request for compensatory time is not made by an
31	employee under this section, the director shall pay regular and overtime
32	compensation at the time it is earned according to the employee's customary
33	salary schedule.
34	(c) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, a department
35	employee shall use compensatory time granted under this section within one
36	(1) year from the date that the compensatory time was earned.

1	(d) The director may provide that a department employee who fails to
2	use compensatory time within the time required by subsection (c) of this
3	section shall:
4	(1) Receive payment for the department employee's unused
5	compensatory time at the rate required by state and federal law at the time
6	the compensatory time was earned; or
7	(2)(A) Forfeit the unused compensatory time unless the director
8	determines that the failure to use the compensatory time is due to
9	circumstances beyond the department employee's control.
10	(B) If the director determines that the failure to use the
11	compensatory time is due to circumstances beyond the department employee's
12	$\underline{\text{control}}, \text{ the director shall pay the compensatory time according to state and}$
13	federal law at the time the compensatory time was earned.
14	(e) This section does not permit the director to fail to comply with
15	state and federal law governing the payment of regular and overtime
16	<pre>compensation."</pre>
