15	WHEREAS, many students of for-profit institutions of higher education
16	claim that the degree they earned is not enabling them to obtain employment
17	in the field of study they trained in or is not transferrable to another
18	institution of higher education; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, the practices and effectiveness of for-profit institutions of
21	higher education have recently been questioned by education experts and
22	policy makers,
23	
24	NOW THEREFORE,
25	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE INTERIM HOUSE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION OF THE EIGHTY-
26	EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27	
28	THAT the Interim House Committee on Education study the impact of for-
29	profit institutions of higher education on Arkansas students.
