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5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

7	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 67, Subchapter 2, is amended		
8	to add a new section to read as follows:		
9	27-67-225. Failure of contractor to pay subcontractor or material		
10	supplier - Authority of State Highway and Transportation Department to issue		
11	joint checks — No consideration of bids.		
12	(a) As used in this section:		
13	(1) "Contractor" means a person that contracts orally or in		
14	writing directly with the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation		
15	Department or the State Highway Commission for the construction, maintenance		
16	or improvement of the roads in the state highway system or for other project		
17	essential to the operation of the state highway system;		
18	(2) "Material Supplier" means a person who supplies materials,		
19	goods, fixtures, or any other tangible item to:		
20	(A) A contractor or subcontractor; or		
21	(B) A person that has direct contractual privity with a		
22	contractor or subcontractor;		
23	(3) "Person" includes an individual, a partnership, a		
24	corporation, a limited liability organization, a trust, or any other business		
25	entity recognized by law;		
26	(4) "Second-Tier Subcontractor" means a person who supplies		
27	labor or services pursuant to a contract with a subcontractor; and		
28	(5) "Subcontractor" means a person who supplies labor or		
29	services pursuant to a contract with the contractor.		
30	(b)(l) The contractor shall pay a subcontractor or a material supplier		
31	its respective subcontract or material contract amount within ten (10)		
32	calendar days after the contractor receives payment from the department.		
33	(2) The payment amount shall be according to the terms of the		
34	subcontract or material contract.		
35	(3) The contractor may withhold a retainage in the amount of ten		
36	percent (10%) or less of the amount due to the subcontractor		

1	(4)(A) Moneys withheld as retainage from subcontractors must be
2	returned within thirty (30) calendar days after the subcontractor's work is
3	satisfactorily completed, whether the contractor's work is complete or not.
4	(B) For the purpose of the prompt return of retainage,
5	"satisfactorily completed" means that:
6	(i) The subcontractor's work has been completed in
7	accordance with the plans and specifications;
8	(ii) The required paperwork, including material
9	certifications, and payrolls have been received and approved by the Chief
10	Engineer of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department;
11	(iii) The subcontractor does not have a past-due
12	balance with a material supplier for work associated with the project; and
13	(iv) The engineer has determined the final
14	quantities for the subcontractor's portion of the work.
15	(C) Delay or postponement of payment to a subcontractor
16	may only be effected after the contractor has established good cause and
17	received written approval from the engineer.
18	(c)(1) If the contractor fails to pay a subcontractor or material
19	supplier within ten (10) calendar days after the contractor receives payment
20	from the department and according to the terms of the subcontract or material
21	contract, all or any portion of subsequent payments due to the contractor may
22	be withheld by the engineer, department, or commission.
23	(2) The engineer, department, or commission may issue a joint
24	check from payment due to the contractor, made payable jointly to the
25	general contractor and the subcontractor or material supplier when the
26	contractor fails to pay a subcontractor or material supplier within ten (10)
27	calendar days after the contractor receives payment from the department and
28	according to the terms of the subcontract or material contract.
29	(d)(1) A contractor must include in its subcontract or material
30	contract notice to a subcontractor and material supplier of its right to
31	prompt payment and return of retainage.
32	(2) A contractor must also include in its subcontract notice to
33	a subcontractor that the contractor requires that the subcontractor pay
34	second-tier subcontractors and material suppliers within ten (10) calendar
35	days after the subcontractor receives payment from the contractor and
36	according to the terms of the second-tier subcontract or material contract

(e) The department and commission shall not consider any proposal or bid from a prime contractor for future contracts with the department when the prime contractor has sublet its performance of a prior contract with the department to a subcontractor or material supplier and failed to pay the subcontractor or material supplier for work or materials provided pursuant to the terms of the subcontract or material contract.
