18	AND TO PROVIDE FOR INTERNET DISCLOSURE.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 63, Subchapter 2 is amended
24	to add a new section to read as follows:
25	5-63-205. Illegal ticket brokering — Disclosure of ticket
26	availability.
27	(a) As used in this section:
28	(1)(A) "Event" means an event or venue for sports, theater,
29	musical performance, or other public entertainment or amusement of any kind.
30	(B) "Event" does not mean a collegiate event managed by a
31	public or private college or university or an event managed by a public or
32	private kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12) school;
33	(2) "Holds back tickets" means to divert or hold back tickets
34	from the initial sale of the tickets to the general public by or on behalf
35	of:
36	(A) A performer;

1	(B) A promoter;
2	(C) A sponsor;
3	(D) The owner or manager of the event; or
4	(E) An affiliate of or a person contracting with a person
5	listed in this subdivision (a)(2);
6	(3) "Initial seller" means a person or entity with whom an event
7	provider has contracted for the sale of tickets to the event for the purpose
8	of the initial sale of the tickets to the general public;
9	(4) "Onsale date" means the date and time when tickets are made
10	available to the general public, including without limitation fan clubs,
11	businesses, and persons for promotional activities; and
12	(5) "Ticket" means a ticket of admission to an event.
13	(b)(l) A person commits illegal ticket brokering if he or she
14	knowingly:
15	(A) Offers for sale as an initial seller all tickets to an
16	event;
17	(B) Holds back tickets to the event; and
18	(C) Does not provide two (2) weeks before the onsale date
19	the number of tickets for the event that were held back from sale to the
20	general public:
21	(i) On the initial seller's website or the event
22	provider's website; or
23	(ii) To a person upon specific request by the
24	person.
25	(c) Illegal ticket brokering is a Class A misdemeanor.
26	(d) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this section if
27	the event for which the tickets were sold was at a venue that contained fewer
28	than one thousand (1,000) seats or accommodated fewer than one thousand
29	(1,000) persons.
