23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-101(a), concerning polling sites
26	designated by the county board of election commissioners, is amended to read
27	as follows:
28	(a)(1) The county board of election commissioners shall:
29	(A) Establish election precincts; and
30	(B)(i) Designate a polling site for each precinct.
31	(ii) A polling site may serve two (2) or more
32	precincts, including parts of precincts.
33	(iii) The county board of election commissioners may
34	designate a retail store owned by a private entity as a polling site.
