11	FISCAL SESSION SO THAT REGULAR SESSIONS OCCUR IN
12	EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS AND FISCAL SESSIONS OCCUR IN ODD-
13	NUMBERED YEARS AS AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE 5, SECTION 5,
14	OF THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION; TO AMEND PROVISIONS OF
15	ARKANSAS LAW RESULTING FROM INITIATED ACT 4 OF 1948
16	AND INITIATED ACT 1 OF 1956; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

20	ALTERING THE REGULAR SESSION AND FISCAL
21	SESSION SO THAT REGULAR SESSIONS OCCUR IN
22	EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS AND FISCAL SESSIONS
23	OCCUR IN ODD-NUMBERED YEARS AS AUTHORIZED
24	BY ARTICLE 5, SECTION 5, OF THE ARKANSAS
25	CONSTITUTION.
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28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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30	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-2-101 is amended to read as follows:
31	10-2-101. Time for meeting.
32	(a) (1) The General Assembly shall meet in regular session at 12:00
33	noon on the second Monday in January in each odd-numbered even-numbered year.
34	(2)(A) However, in any odd-numbered year following the election
35	of a nonincumbent governor, the General Assembly upon convening at 12:00 noon
36	on the second Monday in January may remain in session only for such time not

1	to exceed two (2) days as is necessary to open and publish the votes for
2	various constitutional offices, to swear in the state constitutional officers
3	and members of the General Assembly, to organize and select officers, and to
4	otherwise prepare for the regular session.
5	(B) The General Assembly may then stand in recess for a
6	period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
7	(b)(1) The General Assembly shall meet in a fiscal session at 12:00
8	noon on the second Monday in February of each even-numbered odd-numbered year
9	to ;
10	(A) To consider appropriation bills; and
11	(B) In an odd-numbered year following the election of a
12	<pre>governor, to:</pre>
13	(i) Open and publish the votes for various
14	<pre>constitutional offices;</pre>
15	(ii) Swear in the state constitutional officers and
16	members of the General Assembly; and
17	(iii) Organize and select officers.
18	(2) A bill other than an appropriation bill may be considered in
19	a fiscal session if two-thirds ($2/3$) of the members of each house of the
20	General Assembly approve consideration of the nonappropriation bill.

- 33 (a) Any part-time state board or commission that has not convened a meeting or has convened without a quorum for two (2) consecutive, regularly

- (b)(1) If a part-time state board or commission has not convened a regularly scheduled meeting or has convened without a quorum for four (4) consecutive, regularly scheduled meeting dates within a two-year period, the Joint Performance Review Committee shall reevaluate the purpose, need, and effectiveness of the board or commission.
- (2) The Joint Performance Review Committee shall report its findings and any recommendations concerning the existence of the board or commission to the Legislative Council no later than December 1 of each even-numbered odd-numbered year and shall draft legislation to implement the recommendations.
- (c) No later than August 1 of each even-numbered odd-numbered year, each part-time board and commission shall provide the committee with a list of the regularly scheduled meeting dates for the board or commission for the previous two (2) fiscal years, including the attendance record of each member and the number of meetings that were convened.

SECTION 22. Arkansas Code § 25-4-120 is amended to read as follows: 25-4-120. Revisions to budget, purchasing, and personnel process.

- (a)(1) Prior to June 30 of each even-numbered odd-numbered year, the Legislative Council shall conduct a review of the state budget, purchasing, and personnel process used by state agencies regarding information technology.
- (2) The Legislative Council shall prepare recommendations for changes in the information technology budget process for utilization in the development of state agency budgets for the next biennial budget cycle.
- (b) All agencies of the executive branch shall cooperate fully with the Legislative Council to accomplish the purposes of this section.
- (c) The Department of Information Systems shall make recommendations regarding revisions to the state budget, purchasing, and personnel process related to information technology to the Legislative Council by March 1 of each even numbered odd-numbered year.
