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25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-1-101 is amended to read as follows:	
28	6-11-101. Members.	
29	(a) <u>(1)</u> The State Board of Education shall be composed of nine (9)	
30	members, each of whom is elected in the manner required under the general	
31	<u>election laws of this state as follows</u> :	
32	(1)<u>(</u>A) Two (2) members to be selected <u>elected</u> from each o	f
33	the congressional districts of the state as they exist on the July 31, 2007;	
34	and	
35	(2) (B) One (1) member to be appointed <u>elected as a member</u>	
36	at large from within the state.	

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1	(2) A candidate shall file for office with the Secretary of
2	State in the manner required under the general election laws of this state.
3	(b) (1) The term of office of a member of the state board shall be for
4	a single term of seven (7) years<u>:</u>
5	(1)(A) Shall be four (4) years.
6	(B) The terms shall be staggered as follows:
7	(i) One (1) member from each congressional district
8	shall serve an initial term of two (2) years;
9	(ii) One (1) member from each congressional district
10	shall serve an initial term of four (4) years; and
11	(iii) The member-at-large shall serve an initial
12	term of four (4) years;
13	(2) Shall be limited to two (2) four-year terms; and
14	(3) Shall begin on January 1 and end on December 31.
15	(2)(A) Any member appointed to the state board to fill a vacancy
16	for an uncompleted term with less than three (3) years remaining on the
17	original term may be reappointed to an additional term of seven (7) years.
18	(B) No member serving three (3) or more years on the state
19	board may be reappointed.
20	(3) No current or new member shall be allowed to resign in order
21	to be appointed to a new term on the state board.
22	(4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to change the
23	terms of any member of the state board who was appointed prior to June 3,
24	2004.
25	(c) The membership of the state board shall reflect the diversity in
26	general education.
27	(d)(1) No person may serve as a member of the state board unless he or
28	she is a qualified elector and is a person of high moral standards and
29	recognized ability.
30	(2)(c) A member of the state board:
31	(1) Shall be a qualified elector who is twenty-five (25) years
32	<u>of age or older;</u>
33	(2) For a position representing a congressional district, shall
34	be a resident of the congressional district from which he or she is seeking
35	election for one (1) year preceding the election; and
36	(3) Shall not be:

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1	(A) Neither the The Commissioner of Education nor any;
2	(B) A candidate for any other public office;
3	(C) The holder of a public office in the state ,
4	<u>(D)</u> schoolteacher <u>An employee of a public school or school</u>
5	<u>district in this state</u> ;
6	<u>(E) A</u> county or city superintendent ,
7	<u>(F) An</u> employee of a state-supported college or
8	university, <u>institution of higher education;</u> or
9	<u>(G) A</u> member of any board of trustees of any state <u>a</u>
10	<u>state-supported</u> institution of higher learning shall serve as a member of the
11	state board education in this state.
12	(c)<u>(</u>d) The members of the state board shall be appointed by the
13	Governor, subject to the confirmation of the Senate and shall take the oath
14	of office for officers prescribed by the Arkansas Constitution.
15	(f)(l)<u>(</u>e)(l) Whenever a vacancy occurs in the membership of the state
16	board by death, resignation, or removal from office, the Governor shall
17	appoint a successor who shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term of
18	the member that whom he or she succeeded, subject to all other provisions of
19	this section.
20	(2) Resignation, removal from the district from which he or she
21	is appointed, disqualification, incapacitation from mental or physical
22	disability or otherwise, or change in status from the eligibility
23	requirements for membership on the state board shall automatically create a
24	vacancy in the membership of the state board, and no such member shall
25	thereafter exercise any of the functions of membership on the state board
26	even though his or her successor has not been appointed <u>The Governor shall</u>
27	fill a vacancy with a person who meets the qualifications for the position
28	<u>vacated</u> ,
29	(g)(l) Members of the state board shall be subject to removal from
30	office by the Governor when the actions or condition of a member shall be
31	considered as sufficient cause for removal.
32	(2) However, before a member may be removed for cause, this
33	cause must have been accepted as true, good, and sufficient by a majority
34	written vote of all members of the state board after a formal hearing at a
35	regular or special session of the state board.

1	(h)(f) The members of the state board shall serve without remuneration
2	but may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-
3	16-901 et seq., as follows:
4	(1) Actual expenses while attending regular and special meetings
5	of the state board; and
6	(2) A per diem allowance when in attendance at regular or
7	special meetings of the state board.
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9	SECTION 2. <u>TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY.</u>
10	(a) The first election of members of the State Board of Education
11	under this act shall be the 2014 general election.
12	(b)(1) The term of a person who is a member of the state board on the
13	effective date of this act or who is appointed to the state board after the
14	effective date of this act and before the 2014 general election shall expire
15	on December 31, 2014.
16	(2) A person who is a member of the state board before the 2014
17	general election and who meets all other qualifications for members under
18	<u>this act is eligible to be a candidate for a position on the state board in</u>
19	the 2014 general election.
20	(c) At the first regular meeting of the state board following the
21	election, the members representing each of the four (4) congressional
22	districts shall draw for staggered terms as provided under this act.
