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26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 2, is amended
29	to add an additional section to read as follows:
30	<u>6-18-231. Career Path Program.</u>
31	(a) By July 1, 2014, the Department of Education and the Department of
32	<u>Career Education shall develop a Career Path Program for Arkansas public high</u>
33	<u>schools.</u>
34	(b) The program shall provide a student who is sixteen (16), seventeen
35	(17), or eighteen (18) years of age the opportunity to select a career focus
36	and complete vocational-technical training that leads to a certificate of

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1	completion in the vocational-technical area of study and a high school
2	<u>diploma.</u>
3	(c) The purpose of the program is to address the educational and
4	career training of students who:
5	(1) May desire a career path other than the traditional
6	enrollment in postsecondary education as a first-time full-time freshman; or
7	(2) Have left high school and want to return to complete their
8	secondary education.
9	(d)(1) When a student enrolls in the program, the school, the Adult
10	Education Section of the Department of Career Education, the student, and the
11	parent jointly shall develop an education plan for the participating student
12	<u>that:</u>
13	(A) Includes learning opportunities, vocational-technical
14	training, tutoring, and mentoring designed to meet the participating
15	student's needs;
16	(B) Includes meetings with a guidance counselor;
17	(C) Is not based entirely on traditional credit-based
18	instruction;
19	(D) May provide for a minimum number of hours of adult
20	education programming based on:
21	(i) The educational needs of the participating
22	student; and
23	(ii) The employment of the student, if applicable;
24	and
25	(E) May include without limitation transitional courses
26	and courses for concurrent credit.
27	(e) In developing the program, the Department of Education and the
28	Department of Career Education may include without limitation:
29	(1) Exempting the student from the compulsory attendance
30	requirements of § 6-18-201 while the student is participating in the program;
31	(2) Providing counseling, mentoring, tutoring, or other support
32	services identified under the student's education plan;
33	(3) Flexibility in the number of instructional hours required to
34	be delivered on a school campus; and
35	(4) An alternative or dual high school diploma.

1	(f) The State Board of Education and the State Board of Career
2	Education may promulgate rules as necessary to implement this section.
