19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, is amended
22	to create a new section to read as follows:
23	5-4-703. Mandatory minimum sentence for certain felonies.
24	In addition to any other authorized sentence, a person is subject to a
25	mandatory minimum sentence of a term of imprisonment of five (5) years upon
26	conviction for a felony offense if at the time of the commission of the
27	felony offense the person:
28	(1) Has a prior felony conviction for a felony involving
29	violence as defined in § 5-4-501(d);
30	(2) Is subject to an order of protection as provided under § 9-
31	<u>15-201 et seq.; and</u>
32	(3) Is in the possession of a firearm.
