27	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code Title 7, Chapter 1,	is amended to add an	
28	additional section to read	as follows:		
29	7-1-111. Voter Inte	grity Unit — Creation.		
30	(a) There is create	d the Voter Integrity Uni	<u>t.</u>	
31	(b) The unit shall	be composed of five (5) m	members, one (1) each	
32	appointed by the Governor,	Attorney General, Lieute	nant Governor, Speaker of	
33	the House of Representativ	es, and President Pro Tem	pore of the Senate.	
34	(c) Members of the	unit shall be appointed f	for terms of four (4) years	
35	and shall continue to serv	e until their successors	have been appointed and	
36	have taken the official oa	th.		

1	(d)(1) Except as provided under subdivision (d)(2) of this section, a	
2	person shall not be appointed to serve consecutive terms on the unit.	
3	(2) A member of the unit who has been appointed to fill a	
4	vacancy who serves two (2) years or less of an unexpired term may be	
5	appointed to a subsequent four-year term.	
6	(e)(1) A member of the unit shall not be:	
7	(A) A federal, state, or local government official or	
8	<pre>employee;</pre>	
9	(B) An elected official;	
10	(C) A candidate for public office;	
11	(D) A lobbyist under § 21-8-402(11); or	
12	(E) An officer or employee of an organized political	
13	party.	
14	(2)(A) Except as provided under subdivision (e)(2)(B) of this	
15	section, a member of the unit serving his or her term or an employee of the	
16	unit shall not raise funds for, make contributions to, provide services to,	
17	or lend his or her name in support of:	
18	(i) A candidate for election to public office; or	
19	(ii) A ballot issue to be submitted to voters.	
20	(B) A member of the unit serving his or her term or an	
21	employee of the unit may exercise his or her right to vote or sign an	
22	<u>initiative</u> or referendum petition.	
23	(f)(1) The unit shall elect one (1) member to serve as chair.	
24	(2)(A) A majority of the membership shall be a quorum for	
25	conducting business.	
26	(B) An action shall not be taken by the unit except by an	
27	affirmative vote of the majority of those present and voting.	
28	(C) Sanctions shall not be imposed without an affirmative	
29	vote of at least three (3) members.	
30	(3) The vote of each member voting on any action shall be a	
31	public record.	
32	(g)(1) A member of the unit shall serve without compensation but may	
33	receive expense reimbursement under § 25-16-901 et seq.	
34	(2) The board shall be provided office space, support staff, and	
35	secretarial services as necessary by the office of the Secretary of State.	
36	(h) The unit shall meet when the meeting is:	

1	(1) Called by the chair; or		
2	(2) Requested in writing by any three (3) members of the unit.		
3	(i) The unit shall:		
4	(1) Promulgate reasonable rules to implement and administer the		
5	requirements of this subchapter and to govern procedures before the unit,		
6	matters of unit operations, and all investigative and disciplinary procedures		
7	and proceedings;		
8	(2) Promulgate rules establishing procedures, locations, and		
9	notice requirements for meetings; and		
10	(3) Investigate alleged violations of election laws upon a		
11	complaint filed under § 7-6-218 by:		
12	(A) A member of the State Board of Election Commissioners;		
13	(B) A member of a county board of election commissioners;		
14	(C) A county clerk;		
15	(D) An election official;		
16	(E) A poll watcher;		
17	(F) A candidate for office; or		
18	(G) An elected official.		
19	(j) The unit may:		
20	(1) Upon a finding of a violation of the election laws, render		
21	findings and disciplinary action;		
22	(2) Subpoena any person or the books, records, or other		
23	documents being held by any person and take sworn statements;		
24	(3) Administer oaths for the purpose of taking sworn testimony		
25	of witnesses;		
26	(4) Conduct hearings;		
27	(5) Hire staff and legal counsel; and		
28	(6)(A) File suit in the Pulaski County Circuit Court, in the		
29	circuit court of the county where the respondent resides, or, under § 16-17-		
30	706, in the small claims division established in any district court in the		
31	State of Arkansas, to obtain a judgment for the amount of any fine imposed		
32	under this section or to enforce an order of the unit requiring the filing or		
33	amendment of a disclosure form.		
34	(B) An action by the court under subdivision (j)(6)(A) of		
35	this section shall be limited to the question of whether a fine imposed by		
36	the unit has been paid by the defendant.		

T	(C) The fee charged for the fiffing of a suit in any of the			
2	circuit courts in the State of Arkansas shall be waived in actions brought by			
3	the unit.			
4	(k) If the unit issues a subpoena to a financial institution for			
5	records or information regarding a person who is the subject of an			
6	investigation by the unit, the unit shall allow the institution reasonable			
7	notice and opportunity to respond.

10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-6-217, concerning the creation, powers,			
11	and duties of the Arkansas Ethics Commission, is amended to add an additiona			
12	subsection to read as follows:			
13	(i) The commission immediately shall provide to the Voter Integrity			
14	Unit under § 7-1-111 an election complaint filed under this section by:			
15	(1) A member of the State Board of Election Commissioners;			
16	(2) A member of a county board of election commissioners;			
17	(3) A county clerk;			
18	(4) An election official;			
19	(5) A poll watcher;			
20	(6) A candidate for office; or			
21	(7) An elected official.
