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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-617 is amended to read as follows:
26	6-13-617. Oath.
27	(a) Each director elected or appointed shall, within ten (10) days
28	after receiving notice of his or her election or appointment, subscribe to
29	the following oath:
30	"I,,
31	do hereby solemnly swear or affirm, that I will support the Constitution of
32	the United States and the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and that ${ m I}$
33	will not be interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract made by the
34	district of which I am a director, except as permitted by state law and that
35	I will faithfully discharge the duties as school director in

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     School District upon which I am about to enter."
           (b) The county clerk, upon receipt of the oath prescribed for a
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     director, shall immediately commission such persons, and they shall enter at
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     once upon their duties as directors.
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           (c) A director shall hold his or her office until a successor is
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     elected or appointed and qualified.
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           SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-618(a), concerning the organizational
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     meeting of a school district board of directors, is amended to read as
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     follows:
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           6-13-618. Organization - Disbursing officer.
           (a) At the first regular meeting following the later of the
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     certification of the results of the annual school election or the
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     certification of the results of a runoff election after January 1 of each
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     year, the board of directors of each school district shall organize by
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     electing:
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                 (1) One (1) of their number member as president;
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                 (2) One (1) of their number member as vice president; and
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                 (3) A secretary who may be, but need not be, a member of the
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     board of directors.
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           SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-14-101 is amended to read as follows:
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           6-14-101. Applicability of general election laws.
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           (a) The general election laws shall apply to school elections insofar
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     as they are not in conflict with the school election laws.
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           (b) The county board of election commissioners may include the annual
     school election on a separate ballot if the county board determines that a
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     separate ballot is necessary to avoid voter confusion.
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           SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-14-102(a)(1), concerning the annual
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     school election date, is amended to read as follows:
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           (a)(1) The annual school election shall be held in each school district
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     of the state on the third Tuesday in September Tuesday next after the first
     Monday in November of each year.

1	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-14-118 is amended to read as follows:
2	6-14-118. Expenses.
3	(a)(1) In <u>special</u> school elections, the school districts in the county
4	shall reimburse the county for the cost of the election less expenses
5	incurred for election officials at individual polling places, with each
6	school district's share of the total being determined by multiplying the
7	total cost of the election by a fraction, the numerator of which is the
8	number of votes cast in the specific school election and the denominator of
9	which is the total number of votes cast in the entire election.
10	(2) Expenses incurred for election officials at individual
11	polling places shall be paid by the school district in which the polling
12	place is located.
13	(b) At all annual or special elections, the board of directors of each
14	school district shall pay the expenses of the election out of the school
15	fund.
