## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM TEACHER SALARY SCHEDULE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM TEACHER SALARY SCHEDULE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 24, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-2408. Maximum teacher compensation schedule.
(a) The General Assembly finds that the:
(1) General Assembly has a constitutional obligation to ensure
that all school districts in the state have a substantially equal opportunity
to recruit and retain qualified teachers;
(2) Arkansas Supreme Court in 2002 found that "serious
disparities" . . . exist in teacher salaries among school districts within the State of Arkansas" and cited a disparity of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000);
(3) 2014 Teacher Salary Report prepared by the Bureau of Legislative Research found a disparity of over fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) in starting salaries and a gap of almost twenty-six thousand dollars $(\$ 26,000)$ in average salaries; and
(4) General Assembly finds that past measures adopted to address the intrastate teacher salary disparity have proved ineffective. (b) A school district board of directors shall not adopt a salary schedule for licensed teachers that exceeds the minimum teacher salary schedule under \& 6-17-2403(b) by more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
