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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 1, is
22	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
23	20-77-131. Contraception incentive for Medicaid beneficiary.
24	(a) An unmarried individual who has one child and who is receiving
25	Medicaid benefits shall be eligible to receive a one-time contraception
26	incentive from the Department of Human Services if the individual:
27	(1) Consents to have a surgically implanted contraception device
28	or other similar reversible birth control device with a five (5) year or
29	longer period of effectiveness;
30	(2) Receives a surgically implanted contraception device or
31	other similar reversible birth control device with a five (5) year or longer
32	period of effectiveness; and
33	(3) Provides documentation to the department that the individual
34	has fulfilled subdivision (a)(2) of this section.
35	(b) An individual who meets the requirements of subsection (a) shall
36	be eligible for Medicaid reimbursement for the procedure.

1	(c) The department shall:
2	(1) Pursue and implement the provisions of this section within
3	the Arkansas Medicaid Program; and
4	(2) Submit and seek approval of a state plan amendment or
5	waiver, or both, as necessary to implement this section.
6	(d)(1) Implementation of contraception incentives under this section
7	is conditioned upon the receipt of necessary federal approvals.
8	(2) If the department does not receive the necessary federal
9	approvals, the contraception incentive shall not be implemented.
