14	entities often accept credit cards as a form of payment from members of the
15	public for tuition, services, or goods; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, these institutions of higher education and other state
18	entities sometimes charge a fee to members of the public who use a credit
19	card as a form of payment for tuition, services, or goods; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the fees charged by these institutions of higher education and
22	other state entities for using a credit card as a form of payment may be
23	excessive and in some cases as high as forty dollars (\$40.00) per
24	transaction,
25	
26	NOW THEREFORE,
27	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON REVENUE AND TAXATION OF THE
28	NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
29	
30	THAT the House Committee on Revenue and Taxation study the practice by
31	institutions of higher education and other state entities of charging
32	excessive fees to members of the public for using credit cards in
33	transactions for the payment of certain services.
