7	WHEREAS, Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as
8	"PANS", is a clinically defined disorder characterized by the sudden onset of
9	obsessive-compulsive symptoms or eating restrictions, accompanied by two (2)
10	or more symptoms of acute behavioral deterioration or motor and sensory
11	changes, or both; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as
14	"PANS", is caused when an infectious trigger, environmental factors, or other
15	triggers create a misdirected immune response, which results in inflammation
16	of the brain of a child; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as
19	"PANS", was identified in 2012 by Dr. Susan Swedo; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, as doctors are not required to report the number of patients
22	suffering with Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as
23	"PANS", the true number of affected individuals is unknown; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, it is important that there be an improvement and increase in
26 27	knowledge and treatment throughout the State of Arkansas of Pediatric Acute-
27	onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as "PANS", especially for
28	healthcare professionals,
29	NOL THEREFORE
30	NOW THEREFORE,
31 32	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
33	THE NINETI-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARRANSAS;
34	THAT the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor study and
