21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-10-521(b)(2)(A), concerning the length
24	of time for an employer to respond to an initial claim for unemployment
25	benefits, is amended to read as follows:
26	(2)(A) If a last employer fails to respond within ten (10)
27	<u>fifteen (15)</u> calendar days to a notice under this section, the last employer
28	shall be deemed to have waived the right to respond.
