21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-419(b)(5), concerning the possession
24	of a Schedule VI controlled substance, is amended to read as follows:
25	(5) A Schedule VI controlled substance with an aggregate weight,
26	including an adulterant or diluent, of:
27	(A) (i) Less than four ounces (4 oz.) upon conviction is
28	guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
29	(ii)(a) However, if the Schedule VI controlled
30	substance is marijuana, and the person does not have a prior conviction under
31	this subchapter, the offense is an unclassified misdemeanor.
32	(b) The sentence for an unclassified
33	misdemeanor under subdivision (b)(5)(A)(ii)(a) of this section is a fine of
34	not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000);
