18	TO CREATE AN INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR

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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:						
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25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 51, Subchapter 5, is						
26	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:						
27	26-51-515. Full-time law enforcement officer tax credit.						
28	(a) As used in this section:						
29	(1) "Full-time law enforcement officer" means a law enforcement						
30	officer who:						
31	(A) Is employed by and receives a salary authorized by a						
32	law enforcement agency;						
33	(B) Has the statutory authority to enforce the criminal,						
34	traffic or highway laws of the state or of the federal government, and						

1	(C) Has worked for a law enforcement agency for at least
2	twenty-five (25) hours per week for at least eleven (11) months of the
3	calendar year; and
4	(2) "Law enforcement agency" means a municipal police
5	$\underline{\text{department, a county sheriff's office, a law enforcement entity of the } \underline{\text{State}}$
6	of Arkansas, including without limitation the Division of Arkansas State
7	Police, an airport authority, or a federal law enforcement entity.
8	(b)(1) There is allowed an income tax credit against the income tax
9	$\underline{\text{imposed}}$ by this chapter in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for
10	a taxpayer who obtains verification as stated in subsection (c) of this
11	section.
12	(2) The amount of the income tax credit under this section that
13	may be claimed by the taxpayer in a tax year shall not exceed the amount of
14	income tax due by the taxpayer.
15	(c) A taxpayer may receive the credit under subsection (b) of this
16	section if the taxpayer obtains verification as follows:
17	(1) If the taxpayer is the chief law enforcement officer of a
18	law enforcement agency, the taxpayer shall obtain written verification on a
19	form approved by the Department of Finance and Administration that:
20	(A) States that the taxpayer is a full-time law
21	enforcement officer; and
22	(B) Is signed by the second most senior law enforcement
23	officer and the payroll clerk of the law enforcement agency; and
24	(2) If the taxpayer is not the chief law enforcement officer of
25	the law enforcement agency, the taxpayer shall obtain written verification or
26	a form approved by the department that:
27	(A) States that the taxpayer is a full-time law
28	enforcement officer; and
29	(B) Is signed by the taxpayer's immediate supervisor and
30	the chief law enforcement officer of the law enforcement agency.
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32	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this act is effective for tax
33	years beginning on or after January 1, 2021.
