18	TO ABOLISH THE ALLOCATION OF ENROLLMENT
19	POSITIONS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS
20	COLLEGE OF MEDICINE BASED ON
21	CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT AND ARKANSAS
22	RESIDENCY.

25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26	
27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-64-406(b), concerning admissions at the
28	University of Arkansas College of Medicine, is repealed.
29	(b)(1)(A) The board shall allocate the first seventy percent (70%) of
30	the first one hundred fifty (150) enrollment positions for the freshman
31	medical class among Arkansas congressional districts, using the population of
32	each congressional district as determined by the last federal decennial
33	census to determine that district's proportion of the freshman positions so
34	allocated and shall assign those apportioned enrollment positions for each
35	district to those applicants who are legal residents in that particular
36	congressional district.

1	(B) The board shall give additional consideration to rural
2	applicants from medically underserved areas in an effort to address health
3	disparities.
4	$(2)(\Lambda)$ The next fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred
5	fifty (150) freshman enrollment positions shall be allocated to the state at
6	large and assigned to applicants who are legal residents of any place within
7	Arkansas.
8	(B) However, in allocating the fifteen percent (15%) to
9	the state at large, the board may allocate not to exceed one-third (1/3) of
10	the fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred fifty (150) freshman
11	enrollment positions to applicants who do not actually reside in the state
12	but who were born and reared and attended public schools in Arkansas and who
13	in addition thereto shall meet two (2) or more of the following criteria:
14	(i) Applicant is a registered voter in Arkansas;
15	(ii) Applicant holds a current valid Arkansas
16	driver's license;
17	(iii) Applicant or parents of applicant are Arkansas
18	taxpayers;
19	(iv) Parent of applicant resides in or is employed
20	in Arkansas; and
21	(v) Applicant meets other related criteria as may be
22	prescribed by the board.
23	(3) The remaining fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred
24	fifty (150) freshman enrollment positions may be assigned either to legal
25	residents or to nonresidents, however, any qualified legal resident shall
26	have a preference in securing an assignment to a position when compared to a
27	nonresident, and the total number of nonresidents assigned positions shall
28	not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the first one hundred fifty (150)
29	freshman enrollment positions assigned for any school year.
30	(4) The board may provide for an alteration in the percentages
31	set forth in this subsection only if the adherence to these percentages would
32	endanger the accredited rating of the University of Arkansas College of
33	Medicine as determined by the Standards of the Association of American
34	Medical Golleges.
