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29	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Title.</u>	
30	This act shall be known and may be cited as "Lucille's Law".	
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32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-15-302(a)(1)(A), concerning the testing of newborn infants, is	
33	amended to read as follows:	
34	(a)(1)(A) All newborn infants shall be tested for phenylketonuria, hypothyro	idism, galactosemia,
35	cystic fibrosis, sickle-cell anemia, <del>and</del> spinal muscular atrophy <u>, and Krabbe disease, also known as</u>	
36	"globoid cell leukodystrophy".	

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2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-79-1801, concerning definitions related to coverage for	
3	newborn screening for spinal muscular atrophy, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read a	
4	follows:	
5	(5)(A) "Krabbe disease" means a genetic disease that:	
6	(i) Affects the nervous system; and	
7	(ii) Is caused by deficiency of a particular enzyme.	
8	(B) "Krabbe disease" is also known as "globoid cell leukodystrophy".	
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10	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 23-79-1802 is amended to read as follows:	
11	23-79-1802. Coverage for newborn screening for spinal muscular atrophy.	
12	(a) A health benefit plan that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state shall provide coverage	
13	for newborn screening <del>for spinal muscular atrophy</del> by a healthcare professional <del>on or after January 1,</del>	
14	<del>2020</del> :	
15	(1) For spinal muscular atrophy; and	
16	(2) On and after, January 1, 2024, for Krabbe disease.	
17	(b) The coverage for newborn screening for spinal muscular atrophy under this section:	
18	(1) Is not subject to policy deductibles or copayment requirements; and	
19	(2) Does not diminish or limit benefits otherwise allowable under a health benefit plan.
