18	TO REQUIRE SCREENING FOR DEPRESSION OF
19	BIRTH MOTHERS AT THE TIME OF BIRTH; AND
20	TO MANDATE THAT INSURANCE POLICIES COVER
21	SCREENING FOR DEPRESSION OF BIRTH MOTHERS
22	AT THE TIME OF BIRTH.

25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26	
27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 15, Subchapter 1, is
28	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
29	20-15-102. Depression screening for birth mothers at the time of
30	birth.
31	(a) A physician or healthcare provider who is attending a birth in
32	this state or any other person who is attending or providing medical
33	treatment to a birth mother in this state shall facilitate a healthcare
34	provider to screen the birth mother for depression at the time of birth.
35	(b)(1) If the birth mother declines to be screened for depression at
36	the time of birth, the physician or healthcare provider shall record in the

1	patient's medical records that the birth mother was not screened for
2	depression based upon the refusal of the patient.
3	(2) The record of a patient refusal relieves the physician and
4	the healthcare provider of liability under this subsection.
5	(c) Records, reports, data, or other information collected or
6	maintained under this section that identify or could be used to identify an
7	individual patient, healthcare provider, or institution are confidential and
8	are not subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, §
9	25-19-101 et seq., or subject to subpoena, discovery, or introduction into
10	evidence in a civil proceeding.
11	
12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 79, is amended to add an
13	additional subchapter to read as follows:
14	<u>Subchapter 24 - Coverage for Birth Mother Screening for Depression</u>
15	
16	<u>23-79-2401. Definitions.</u>
17	As used in this subchapter:
18	(1) "Birth mother" means the biological mother of a child;
19	(2) "Depression" means a mental illness classified as a mood
20	disorder that causes a persistent feeling of sadness and a loss of interest;
21	(3)(A) "Health benefit plan" means:
22	(i) An individual, blanket, or group plan or a
23	policy, or contract for healthcare services issued or delivered by a
24	healthcare insurer; and
25	(ii) Any health benefit program receiving state or
26	federal appropriations from the State of Arkansas, including the Arkansas
27	Medicaid Program and the Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me Program, or
28	any successor program.
29	(B) "Health benefit plan" includes:
30	(i) Indemnity and managed care plans; and
31	(ii) Nonfederal governmental plans as defined in 29
32	U.S.C. § 1002(32), as it existed on January 1, 2024.
33	(C) "Health benefit plan" does not include:
34	(i) A disability income plan;
35	(ii) A credit insurance plan;

1	(iii) Insurance coverage issued as a supplement to
2	liability insurance;
3	(iv) A medical payment under automobile or
4	homeowner's insurance plans;
5	(v) A health benefit plan provided under Arkansas
6	Constitution, Article 5, § 32, the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et
7	seq., or the Public Employee Workers' Compensation Act, § 21-5-601 et seq.;
8	(vi) A plan that provides only indemnity for
9	hospital confinement;
10	(vii) An accident-only plan;
11	(viii) A specified disease plan;
12	(ix) A long-term-care-only plan;
13	(x) A dental-only plan; or
14	(xi) A vision-only plan;
15	(4) "Healthcare insurer" means an entity subject to the
16	insurance laws of this state or the jurisdiction of the Insurance
17	Commissioner that contracts or offers to contract to provide health insurance
18	coverage, including without limitation an insurance company, a health
19	maintenance organization, a hospital medical service corporation, a self-
20	insured governmental or church plan in this state, or the Arkansas Medicaid
21	Program; and
22	(5) "Healthcare professional" means a person who is licensed,
23	certified, or otherwise authorized by the laws of this state to administer
24	health care in the ordinary course of the practice of his or her profession.
25	
26	23-79-2402. Coverage for birth mother screening for depression.
27	(a) A healthcare insurer that offers, issues, or renews a health
28	benefit plan in this state shall provide coverage for screening for
29	depression of the birth mother by a healthcare professional at the time of
30	birth on or after January 1, 2024.
31	(b) The coverage for screening for depression of the birth mother
32	under this section:
33	(1) Is not subject to policy deductibles or copayment
34	requirements; and
35	(2) Does not diminish or limit benefits otherwise allowable
36	under a health benefit plan.

(c) Coverage provided for screening under subsection (a) of this section for a government self-insured plan is subject to any health benefit plan provisions that apply to other services covered by the health benefit plan. Referred by Representative Pilkington Prepared by: ANS/ANS
