29	29 (a) The General Assembly finds th	hat the importance and necessity of
30	30 providing and regulating the system by w	which healthcare services are
31	31 structured and integrated promotes the a	availability of and access to
32	32 <u>necessary and appropriate healthcare ser</u>	rvices to protect the general health,
33	33 <u>safety</u> , and welfare of the rural resider	nts of this state.
34	34 (b) It is the intent of the Gener	ral Assembly to create a category of
35	35 <u>licensure to enable certain hospitals wi</u>	ithin this state to receive federal
36	36 <u>healthcare reimbursement as rural emerge</u>	ency hospitals in order to:

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1	(1) Improve the health of the rural population of this state;	
2	(2) Preserve access to healthcare services and providers;	
3	(3) Encourage collaboration among healthcare providers;

11	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-9-201, concerning definitions relating	
12	to health facilities, is amended to add additional subdivisions to read as

14	(13) "Rural emergency hospital" means an establishment that:	
15	(A) Meets the eligibility requirements described in this	
16	<u>subchapter;</u>	
17	(B) Provides rural emergency hospital services;	
18	(C) Provides rural emergency services in the facility	
19	twenty-four (24) hours per day by maintaining an emergency department that is	
20	staffed twenty-four (24) hours per day and seven (7) days per week with a	
21	physician, nurse practitioner, clinical nurse specialist, or physician	
22	<u>assistant;</u>	
23	(D) Has a transfer agreement in effect with a Level I or	
24	Level II trauma center; and	
25	(E) Meets other requirements as the Department of Health	
26	<u>finds</u> necessary:	
27	(i) In the interest of the health and safety of	
28	individuals who receive rural emergency hospital services; and	
29	(ii) For implementation of a state licensure that	
30	satisfies requirements for reimbursement by federal healthcare programs as a	
31	rural emergency hospital; and	
32	(14) "Rural emergency hospital services" means the following	
33	services provided by a rural emergency hospital that do not require more than	
34	twenty-four (24) hours on average in a rural emergency hospital:

27	20-9-224. Rural emergency hospitals.		
28	(a) A healthcare facility shall be eligible t	o apply for a	<u>rural</u>
29	emergency hospital license if the healthcare facility on or before December		December
30	<u>27, 2020, was a:</u>		
31	(1) Licensed critical access hospital;		
32	(2) General hospital with not more than fifty (50) licensed beds		
33	located in a county in a rural area under 42 U.S.C. § 1395ww(d)(10)(C)(ii);		
34	or		

1	(3) General hospital with not more than fifty (50) licensed beds
2	that is deemed as being located in a rural area under 42 U.S.C. §
3	<u>1395ww(d)(8)(E).</u>
4	(b) A healthcare facility applying for licensure as a rural emergency
5	hospital shall include with the licensure application:
6	(1) An action plan for initiating rural emergency hospital
7	services, including a detailed transition plan that lists the specific
8	services that the healthcare facility shall retain, modify, add, or
9	discontinue, or any combination of retain, modify, add, or discontinue;
10	(2) A description of services that the healthcare facility
11	intends to provide on an outpatient basis; and
12	(3) Other information as required by rules adopted by the
13	Department of Health.
14	(c) A rural emergency hospital shall not have inpatient beds unless
15	the rural emergency hospital has a unit that is a distinct part of the rural
16	emergency hospital that
17	(1) Is licensed as a skilled nursing facility to provide post-
18	hospital extended care services; or
19	(2) Provides behavioral health services in accordance with the
20	Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me Act of 2021, § 23-61-1001 et seq.
21	(d) A rural emergency hospital may own and operate an entity that
22	provides ambulance services.
23	(e)(1) A licensed general hospital or critical access hospital that
24	applies for and receives licensure as a rural emergency hospital and elects
25	to operate as a rural emergency hospital shall retain its original license as
26	a general hospital or critical access hospital.
27	(2) The original license shall remain inactive while the rural
28	emergency hospital license is in effect.
29	(f)(1) A rural emergency hospital, including a city, county, or other
30	governmental or quasi-governmental hospital, may enter into any contracts
31	required to be eligible for federal reimbursement as a rural emergency
32	hospital.
33	(2)(A) An entity engaging in activities and entering into
34	contracts required to meet the requirements for licensure and reimbursement
35	as a rural emergency hospital and its officers, agents, representatives,
36	employees, and directors are acting pursuant to clearly expressed state

1	policy under the supervision of the state.
2	(B) An entity is not subject to state or federal antitrust
3	laws while acting in this manner.
4	(g) The State Board of Health shall adopt rules establishing the
5	minimum standards for the establishment and operation of rural emergency
6	hospitals in accordance with this section, including licensure of rural
7	emergency hospitals.
8	(h)(l) A health benefit plan that is offered, issued, or renewed in
9	this state shall provide benefits and coverage for services performed by a
10	rural emergency hospital if the services would be covered under the health
11	benefit plan if performed by a general hospital.
12	(2) As used in subdivision (h)(1) of this section, "health
13	benefit plan" means the same as defined in § 23-79-1801.
14	(i) The Arkansas Medicaid Program shall reimburse a rural emergency
15	hospital at the same or greater rate in which critical access hospitals are
16	reimbursed.
